

# Privacy Policy

Effective as of April 12, 2022

This Privacy Policy describes how Fast Break Labs, Inc. (“**Fast Break Labs**,” “**we**,” “**us**” or “**our**”) handles personal information that we collect through our digital properties that link to this Privacy Policy, including our websites and mobile application (collectively, the “**Service**”), as well as through social media, our marketing activities, our live events and other activities described in this Privacy Policy.

## Personal information we collect

**Information you provide to us.** Personal information you may provide to us through the Service or otherwise includes:

- **Contact data**, such as your email address, first and last name, billing and mailing addresses, and phone number.
- **Profile data**, such as your crypto wallet address, the username and password that you may set to establish an online account on the Service, date of birth, your team’s name, acronym and default badges, links to your profiles on social networks (e.g., Discord), interests, preferences, and any other information that you add to your account profile.
- **Gaming data**, such as information relating to your gaming profile and activity, including how many wins and losses per tournament, the composition of your team, who your team competed against, how your team ranks compared to other teams, and other relevant gaming information.
- **Communications data**, based on our exchanges with you, including when you contact us through the Service, social media, or otherwise.
- **Transactional data**, such as information relating to or needed to complete your specific non-fungible token (“NFT”) purchases or sales on or through the Service.
- **Marketing data**, such as your preferences for receiving our marketing communications and details about your engagement with them.
- **User-generated content data**, such as photos, images, comments, questions, messages, works of authorship, and other content or information that you generate, transmit, or otherwise make available on the Service, as well as associated metadata. Metadata includes information on how,

when, where and by whom a piece of content was collected and how that content has been formatted or edited. Metadata also includes information that users can add or can have added to their content, such as keywords, geographical or location information, and other similar data.

- **Financial data**, such as your digital currency or wallet accounts, stored value accounts, and payment data needed to complete transactions, including payment card information or bank account number.
- **Promotional data**, including information you share when you enter a competition, promotion or complete a survey. Please note that if you participate in a sweepstakes, contest or giveaway through the Service, we may ask you for your Contact Data to notify you if you win or not, to verify your identity and/or to send you prizes. In some situations, we may need additional information as a part of the entry process, such as a prize selection choice. These sweepstakes and contests are voluntary. We recommend that you read the rules and other relevant information for each sweepstakes and contest that you enter.
- **Job application data**, such as information you submit in connection with an application for a job (including information in a CV, resume or otherwise collected through the job application process).
- **Other data** not specifically listed here, which we will use as described in this Privacy Policy or as otherwise disclosed at the time of collection.

**Third-party sources.** We may combine personal information we receive from you with personal information we obtain from other sources, such as:

- **Public sources**, such as government agencies, public records, social media platforms, public blockchain(s), and other publicly available sources.
- **Private sources**, such as data providers, social media platforms and data licensors.
- **Our affiliate partners**, such as our affiliate network provider and publishers, influencers, and promoters who participate in our paid affiliate programs.
- **Marketing partners**, such as joint marketing partners and event co-sponsors. For example, we may receive your request to be added to our waitlist through our marketing partners.
- **Third-party services**, such as a third-party service (*e.g.*, Discord), that you use to log into, or otherwise link to, your Service account. This data may include your username, profile picture and other information associated with your account on that third-party service that is made available to us based on your account settings on that service.

**Automatic data collection.** We, our service providers, and our business partners may automatically log information about you, your computer or mobile device, and your interaction over time with the Service, our communications and other online services, such as:

- **Device data**, such as your computer or mobile device's operating system type and version, manufacturer and model, browser type, screen resolution, RAM and disk size, CPU usage, device type (*e.g.*, phone, tablet), IP address, unique identifiers (including identifiers used for advertising purposes), language settings, mobile device carrier, radio/network information (*e.g.*, Wi-Fi, LTE, 3G), and general location information such as city, state or geographic area.
- **Online activity data**, such as pages or screens you viewed, how long you spent on a page or screen, the website you visited before browsing to the Service, navigation paths between pages or screens, information about your activity on a page or screen, access times and duration of access, and whether you have opened our emails or clicked links within them.
- **Location data** when you authorize the Service to access your device's location.

**Cookies and similar technologies.** Some of the automatic collection described above is facilitated by the following technologies:

- **Cookies**, which are small text files that websites store on user devices and that allow web servers to record users' web browsing activities and remember their submissions, preferences, and login status as they navigate a site. Cookies used on our sites include both "session cookies" that are deleted when a session ends, "persistent cookies" that remain longer, "first party" cookies that we place and "third party" cookies that our third-party business partners and service providers place.
- **Local storage technologies**, like HTML5, that provide cookie-equivalent functionality but can store larger amounts of data on your device outside of your browser in connection with specific applications.
- **Web beacons**, also known as pixel tags or clear GIFs, which are used to demonstrate that a webpage or email was accessed or opened, or that certain content was viewed or clicked.
- **Software development kits.** An SDK is third-party computer code that we may incorporate into our mobile applications that may be used for a variety of purposes, including to provide us with analytics regarding the use of our mobile applications, to integrate with social media, or add features or functionality to our app.

**Data about others.** We may offer features that help users invite their friends or contacts to use the Service, and we may collect contact details about these invitees so we can deliver their invitations. Please do not refer someone to us or share their contact details with us unless you have their permission to do so.

## How we use your personal information

We may use your personal information for the following purposes or as otherwise described at the time of collection:

**Service delivery and business operations.** We may use your personal information to:

- provide, operate and improve the Service and our business;
- establish and maintain your user profile on the Service;
- facilitate your invitations to friends who you want to invite to join the Service;
- enable security features of the Service, such as by sending you security codes via email or SMS, and remembering devices from which you have previously logged in;
- communicate with you about the Service, including by sending announcements, updates, security alerts, and support and administrative messages;
- communicate with you about events or contests in which you participate;
- understand your needs and interests, and personalize your experience with the Service and our communications; and
- provide support for the Service, and respond to your requests, questions and feedback.

**Research and development.** We may use your personal information for research and development purposes, including to analyze and improve the Service and our business.

**Marketing.** We, our service providers and our third-party advertising partners, may collect and use your personal information for marketing and advertising purposes:

- **Direct marketing.** You may opt-out of our marketing communications as described in the [Opt-out of marketing](#) section below.

- **Interest-based advertising.** Our third-party advertising partners may use cookies and similar technologies to collect information about your interaction (including the data described in the automatic data collection section above) with the Service, our communications and other online services over time, and use that information to serve online ads that they think will interest you. This is called interest-based advertising. We may also share information about our users with these companies to facilitate interest-based advertising to those or similar users on other online platforms.

**To manage our recruiting and process job applications.** We may use personal information, such as information submitted to us in a job application, to facilitate our recruitment activities and process job applications, such as by evaluating a candidate for a job, and monitoring recruitment statistics.

**Compliance and protection.** We may use your personal information to:

- comply with applicable laws, lawful requests, and legal process, such as to respond to subpoenas or requests from government authorities;
- protect our, your or others' rights, privacy, safety or property (including by making and defending legal claims);
- audit our internal processes for compliance with legal and contractual requirements or our internal policies;
- enforce the terms and conditions that govern the Service; and
- prevent, identify, investigate and deter fraudulent, harmful, unauthorized, unethical or illegal activity, including cyberattacks and identity theft.

**With your consent.** In some cases, we may specifically ask for your consent to collect, use or share your personal information, such as when required by law.

**To create aggregated, de-identified and/or anonymized data.** We may create aggregated, de-identified and/or anonymized data from your personal information and other individuals whose personal information we collect. We make personal information into de-identified and/or anonymized data by removing information that makes the data identifiable to you. We may use this aggregated, de-identified and/or anonymized data and share it with third parties for our lawful business purposes, including to analyze and improve the Service and promote our business.

**Cookies and similar technologies.** In addition to the other uses included in this section, we may use the [Cookies and similar technologies](#) described above for the following purposes:

- **Technical operation.** To allow the technical operation of the Service, such as by remembering your selections and preferences as you navigate the site, and whether you are logged in when you visit password protected areas of the Service.
- **Functionality.** To enhance the performance and functionality of our services.
- **Advertising.** To help our third-party advertising partners collect information about how you use the Service and other online services over time, which they use to show you ads on other online services they believe will interest you and measure how the ads perform.
- **Analytics.** To help us understand user activity on the Service, including which pages are most and least visited and how visitors move around the Service, as well as user interactions with our emails. For example, we use Google Analytics for this purpose. **Retention.** We generally retain personal information to fulfill the purposes for which we collected it, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, accounting, or reporting requirements, to establish or defend legal claims, or for fraud prevention purposes. To determine the appropriate retention period for personal information, we may consider factors such as the amount, nature, and sensitivity of the personal information, the potential risk of harm from unauthorized use or disclosure of your personal information, the purposes for which we process your personal information and whether we can achieve those purposes through other means, and the applicable legal requirements.

When we no longer require the personal information we have collected about you, we may either delete it, anonymize it, or isolate it from further processing.

## How we share your personal information

We may share your personal information with the following parties and as otherwise described in this Privacy Policy or at the time of collection.

**Affiliates.** Our corporate parent, subsidiaries, and affiliates, for purposes consistent with this Privacy Policy.

**Service providers.** Third parties that provide services on our behalf or help us operate the Service or our business (such as hosting, information technology, customer support, email delivery, marketing, consumer research and website analytics).

**Payment processors.** Any payment card information you use to make a purchase on the Service is collected and processed directly by our payment processors, such as PayPal. PayPal may use your payment data in accordance with its privacy policy, <https://www.paypal.com/us/webapps/mpp/ua/privacy-full>.

**Cryptocurrency platforms.** Any information collected necessary to process an NFT purchase (such as your wallet address) is collected and processed directly by your chosen cryptocurrency platform. Please review the privacy policies for the relevant cryptocurrency platform to learn how they may use your payment information. **Advertising partners.** Third-party advertising companies for the [interest-based advertising purposes](#) described above.

**Partners.** We may sometimes share your personal information with partners, such as when we share your Discord usernames with our partners.

**Linked third-party services.** If you log into the Service with, or otherwise link your Service account to, a social media or other third-party service, we may share your personal information with that third-party service. The third party's use of the shared information will be governed by its privacy policy and the settings associated with your account with the third-party service.

**Professional advisors.** Professional advisors, such as lawyers, auditors, bankers and insurers, where necessary in the course of the professional services that they render to us.

**Authorities and others.** Law enforcement, government authorities, and private parties, as we believe in good faith to be necessary or appropriate for the [compliance and protection purposes](#) described above.

**Business transferees.** Acquirers and other relevant participants in business transactions (or negotiations of or due diligence for such transactions) involving a corporate divestiture, merger, consolidation, acquisition, reorganization, sale or other disposition of all or any portion of the business or assets of, or equity interests in, Fast Break Labs or our affiliates (including, in connection with a bankruptcy or similar proceedings).

**Other users and the public.** Your team's name and other user-generated content data (except for private messages) may be visible to other users of the Service and the public. For example, other users of the Service or the public may have access to your information if you chose to make your profile or other personal information available to them through the Service, such as when you provide comments, reviews, survey responses, or share other content. This information can be seen, collected and used by others, including being cached, copied, screen captured or stored elsewhere by others (e.g., search engines), and we are not responsible for any such use of this information.

We make commercially reasonable efforts to verify that the parties with whom our mobile application shares personal information provide a level of protection of personal information consistent with the practices described in this Privacy Policy, except that all such parties described above other than service providers and affiliates may, to the extent permitted by law, use personal information as described in their own privacy policies.

## Your choices

**Access or update your information.** If you have registered for an account with us through the Service, you may review and update certain account information by logging into the account.

**Opt-out of marketing communications.** You may opt-out of marketing-related emails by following the opt-out or unsubscribe instructions at the bottom of the email, or by [contacting us](#). Please note that if you choose to opt-out of marketing-related emails, you may continue to receive service-related and other non-marketing emails.

**Mobile location data.** You can disable our access to your device's precise geolocation in your mobile device settings.

**Advertising choices.** You may be able to limit use of your information for interest-based advertising through the following settings/options/tools:

You will need to apply these opt-out settings on each device and browser from which you wish to limit the use of your information for interest-based advertising purposes.

We cannot offer any assurances as to whether the companies we work with participate in the opt-out programs described above.

**Declining to provide information.** We need to collect personal information to provide certain services. If you do not provide the information we identify as required or mandatory, we may not be able to provide those services.

**Linked third-party platforms.** If you choose to connect to the Service through your social media account or other third-party platform, you may be able to use your settings in your account with that platform to limit the information we receive from it. If you revoke our ability to access information from a third-party platform, that choice will not apply to information that we have already received from that third party.

## Children

The Service is not intended for use by anyone under 18 years of age. If you are a parent or guardian of a child from whom you believe we have collected personal information in a manner prohibited by law, please [contact us](#). If we learn that we have collected personal information through the Service from a

child without the consent of the child's parent or guardian as required by law, we will comply with applicable legal requirements to delete the information.

## Changes to this Privacy Policy

We reserve the right to modify this Privacy Policy at any time. If we make material changes to this Privacy Policy, we will notify you by updating the date of this Privacy Policy and posting it on the Service or other appropriate means. Any modifications to this Privacy Policy will be effective upon our posting the modified version (or as otherwise indicated at the time of posting). In all cases, your use of the Service after the effective date of any modified Privacy Policy indicates your acknowledgment that the modified Privacy Policy applies to your interactions with the Service and our business.
